EDUCATION COMMITTEE CHARTER

Committee Purpose:

Develop and implement IAIR's educational programs.

Committee Responsibilities and Duties:

The charges of the Education Committee include, but are not limited to, the following:

- To oversee the development, maintenance, execution and review of educational programs and tools which will benefit the IAIR membership as a whole.
- To periodically assess existing programs, their execution, and their value to the mission of IAIR.
- To provide mechanisms to evaluate execution and content of programs and relevant information in order to learn and continuously improve future educational opportunities.
- To support and encourage more input and participation from IAIR members and partners as educational opportunities are considered and implemented.
- To thoughtfully consider the needs of an ever-changing community and develop content which can be retained and used indefinitely by future members.
- To provide perspective and support to developers and hosts of programs, ensuring the entirety of the program is delivered and executed in a way which benefits attendees and the mission of IAIR.

Qualifications for committee members (if any besides active IAIR membership):

General understanding of key elements for successful workshops/events, including both in person and virtual formats.

Commitment (both time and overall term):

2 hours per month; 2 year unlimited renewable term
